

- There is a danger of fire by over heat.




- 2.Do not handle plug with wet hand

- There is a danger of electric shock.






- 3.Do not use damaged power cable

after use.






#### 7.Do not use near fire

- · There is a danger of injury by dropping appliance on the foot.


11.Do not allow children to play around dishwasher when opening or closing door due to the possibility of small fingers being pinched in door.






- 2.Check power voltage

 Only use detergents and rinse aids recommended for proper dishwashers. Never use soap, laundry detergent or hand dishwashing detergent as it will cause leak.



4.Keep children away from detergents and rinse-aid.



# 5.Do not allow children to operate the dishwasher.

- Please do not open the door by over flapping and avoid the shock from slamming door.
- · It may cause a damage to the appliance.



#### 6.Be careful of electricity when cleaning

- Please see to it that the power plug is pulled off before cleaning.
- There is a danger of electric shock.

# Basic Understanding on Installation and Operation

 Warning: If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified in order to avoid electrical shock.

# **Marning**

#### 1.Check Power Voltage

- This product is operate only on AC 230V 50Hz power source.
- Unit is so positioned that plug is accessible.

#### 2.Checking Water(Supply) Valve

 Make sure water is not leaked from any fittings and fully open the water faucet.

#### 3.Checking Usage

- This product is used exclusively for cleaning domestic crockery and cutlery.
- Do not use it for other purpose.

- 4. Avoid below conditions
  - In damp or cold places and directly exposed to sunlight.

5. Under certain condition, Hydrogen gas may be produced in a hot water system that has not been used for two weeks or more. HYDROGEN GAS IS EXPLOSIVE. If the hot water system has not been used for such a period, before using the dishwasher turn on all hot water faucet's and let the water flow from each for several minutes. This will release any accumulated hydrogen gas.

As the gas is flammable, do not smoke or use an open flame during this time.




#### Part Name

#### ♠ Note

Your dishwasher has been checked thoughtly in the factory to ensure that it is in working order.

This may cause small water strains. These will disappear after the first wash cycle.





# Preparation for Washing

1. Connect the power plug to a power supply (230V only). This product is operated only AC 230V 50Hz power source.



- 2. Open the water valve
- 3. Remove all leftovers of food from crockery for example pits, bones, pieces of solid food before putting into the basket of dishwasher.



- 4. Grasp the handle, pull down the door of dishwasher.
- 5. Load dishes into the rack. Make sure the filter is fixed to the right position.

- 6. Place about 10g of detergent in the detergent dispenser. Close the cover. When using Intensive wash program, put about 12g of detergent in the dispenser. (See pages 17)
- 7. Close the door

# Start Dishwashing

#### Before using the Magic dishwasher

#### 1. Set the water softener

▶ The Magic dishwasher is equipped with adjusting the water softening system.

To avoid scale deposit on the dishes and in the dishwasher, the dishes must be washed with soft water, i.e. water with a low lime content.

The water softener should be adjusted according to the hardness of the water in your area. Your local Water Authority can advise you on the hardness of the water in your area.

- ▶ The water softener must be set electrically.
  - If you want to change the setting of the water softener,
  - 1. Press the POWER button to turn off. (The dishwasher must be switched off.)
  - 2. Press the button in order. (At this time a button sound is heard.)
    - ① Press the +Program button for three seconds.
    - 2 Press the Start/Pause button.
  - 3. To change the water softener level, Press Program button.

    (For the selection of the new level see the chart, Please See pages 21.)
- ⚠ We recommend our customer to set the water softener when the dishwasher is initially installed by a technician.
- 2. Fill up with special salt for water softeners. (See pages 19, 20)
- 3. Fill up with rinse aid. (See pages 18)
- \*\* If any you wish to use tablet detergent such a : "2 in 1, 3 in 1, 4 in 1, 5 in 1" etc...,
  To get optimum effects of water soft, you fill up with special salt for water softener.
  But, Do not fill up with rinse aid as you use tablet detergent.
  - Never pour detergent into the salt dispenser, otherwise you will destroy the water softening system.

1. Press the power button.



2. Select the desired program.

See pages 13



3. Start the dishwasher by pressing Start / Pause / a Button.



#### After dishwashing

- ▶ Please take it in turns
  - 1. The display indicator will turn off automatically with buzz after dishwashing completion.

Thus unnecessary to press the Power button.

- 2. Remove the filter inside of the dishwasher.
- 3. Be careful not to drop the garbages into the dishwasher.
- 4. Clean all filters thoroughly under running water.
- 5. Re-insert the coarse filter into the flat filter.
- 6. Put the flat filter inside of the dishwasher.
- ▶ For more information, See pages 25.
- ⚠ The filter must be checked and cleaned from time to time.



#### Control Panel

- ▶ A washing program must be selected before starting operation. The program can be changed during operation.
- In order to change the program after starting operation, press the Start / Pause Button at first and then changed the desired program. (except delay start Button) In this case, the program is restart from first washing process.
- ► Child Lock
- Use Child Lock to prevent unintended use of the dishwasher.

Magic

- When Child Lock is selected, all buttons are disabled.
- For locking / unlocking, press start / pause button more than 3 seconds.

A Rinse Dry, Fruit program do not need dishwasher detergent.

#### Clock

- Use this Clock button to adjust time. (Press the button more than 5 seconds.)
- Press the button to check the currunt time when dishwasher operating.
- -Time adjusting (See pages 12)

#### Program

- The procedure indicator will be changed when this button is pressed each time.
- Press the select button to select one of the seven available wash program.
- By Pressing select button, the program is selected in order of Intensive --> Eco.
- --> Quick --> Rinse Dry
- --> Glass Care --> Fruit --> Normal"
- Operating child lock by pressing about 3 seconds.

#### **Procedure Indicator**

- The procedure indicator shows progress of washing program.
- The completed washing process turn off and a going process is flashed.
- All procedure indicators will turn off when washing is completed.

#### **Delay Start**

- Use this Delay Start Button to preset starting time.
- The remain time indigator will be changed when this button is pressed each time.
- -The delay start time can be adjusted from 1 hour to 24hours.

#### All in 1

- If you wish to use tablet detergent such a: "2 in 1", "3 in 1", "4 in 1" etc.
   You select the desired program before and after. Press the Multi in 1 button.
- Use only Nomal / ECO/ Intensive / Glass Care / Quick program.
- When the Multi in 1 function is activitiesd, a washing time is automatically changed.
- The refilling of the rinse aid dispenser is no longer necessary.
- But Fill up with special salt for water softener.

#### +Program

 Use the +Program Button in order to add the dry and rinse process to the original program, in the course of the rinse course, this button will not be selected.

#### Control Panel

#### ▶ Power Button

Press the power button it turn power on or off

#### ▶ Start / Pause Button

Press the Start / Pause button to operate dishwashing.

Press this button to pause and change wash program when dishwashing is operating.

#### ▶ Program Button

The indicator will be changed when this button is pressed each time. Intensive --> Eco. --> Quick --> Rinse Dry --> Glass Care --> Fruit --> Normal

#### ▶ Procedure Indicator

Selected washing program flicker until program is completed, In addition other indicator is unilluminated.

#### ▶ Clock, Remain Time Indicator

Normally displayed the current time.

Remaining time will be indicated during washing program.

The remaining hours up to program completed.

- \* Time adjusting (Can not adjust time during washing program)
- 1) Press the CLOCK button for 5 seconds, the hour value blinks.
- 2) Press the PROGRAM button to adjust hour.
- 3) Press the CLOCK button, the minute value would blink, press the PROGRAM button to adjust minute. And then press CLOCK button to back clock mode.

#### ▶ +Program Button

Use the +program button in order to add the dry and rinse process to the original program, in the course of the rinse course, this button will not be selected.

The procedure indicator will be changed from +Rinse --> + Rinse + Dry, --> + Dry when the +program button is pressed each time.

#### ▶ Delay Start Button

Use the Delay Start button to preset starting time.

The remain time indicator will be changed when the Delay Start button is pressed each time.



# Loading Dishes

#### Operating Method

#### ▶ Normal

- 1. Press the Power button
- 2. Press the Start / Pause button
  Start the dishwasher and a during sound is heard
- ▶ Delay Start
  - 1. Press the Power button
  - 2. Choice the Washing Program

    Please select the washing program according to the degree of the soiled dishes.
  - 3. Press the Delay Start button

The indicator will be changed when you press the Delay Start button.



4. Press the Start / Pause button

The Delay Start indicator flashes when you press the Start / Pause button, the dishwasher starts operating.

- ▶ Changing from Rinse Dry program to Intensive washing program
  - 1. Press the power button
  - 2. Press the Program button
    Press consecutively the select washing program button.
  - 3. Press the Start / Pause button Start Rinse Dry wash.
  - 4. Press the Start / Pause button Stop Rinse Dry wash program.
  - Select Intensive washing Program.
     The Intensive indicator is on when you press the program button.
     Check the detergent dispensers. They must be filled properly for the new program.
  - 6. Press the Start / Pause Button to start Intensive washing program Start the dishwasher and a draining sound is heard




# Loading Dishes

#### Loading the dish

- 1. The rack accommodates items such as plate, platters, saucepans, bowls, etc.
- 2.Deep-bottomed bowls should be placed slant-upwards to let water run down.
- 3. Hollow items must be inverted to the rotor.

5.Remove all leftovers of food - e.g. potatoes, pasta, bones and fruit bones from crockery before loading it into the basket.



6.Temperature sensitive brittle glassware and light bowls are not suitable for washing in the dishwasher. Especially temperature sensitive plastic articles, lacquerware, cutlery with wood, silver dishes are not suitable for machine washing.

#### Unloading the dish

↑ Hot steam may escape when the door is opened.

There is a risk of scalding.

#### How to use the cup rack

- 1. The cup rack is placed on the top left of rack.
- 2. Move the upper part of the cup rack as shown in the diagram.





#### Directions for the use of rack

⚠ Do not use the inside of rack handle. You must not place inside of rack handle on the vertical position








# **Loading Dishes**

**Warning** Knives and other utensils with sharp points must be loaded in the rack with their points down or placed in a horizontal position.





Spoon, Knife, ladle, fork, etc



- ▶ Items not recommeded for dishwashing
  - Copper or anodized alumium
  - Hand painted silver or gold leaf crockery
  - · Wood handled utensils
  - Iron or non rust proof utensils
  - · Plastic items which are not dishwasher safe

#### Example loading arrangement





Ensure that the load does not cover the integrated rinse aid and detergent dispenser. Before closing the door, ensure that the spray arm rotate freery.


# Detergent and Rinse-aid Dispenser

#### How to Use the Detergent Dispenser

Push the latch to open. (The flap is always opened at the end of a washing program.)



Add detergent to this compartment and close the flap.



#### ▶ Amount of detergent

- Detergent must be put into the detergent hole before starting every program except the detergent free
- Proper amount of detergent is lead to best performance
- The amount of detergent depends on the program. Refer to the guide table
- Use only special detergent designed of an automatic dishwasher. (Ordinary handwashing detergent should not be used, because the foam can interfere with profer opeation)
- The detergent used is a special Dishwasher detergent and like all household chemicals should be treated as a poison and kept out of reach of children.
- \* Fruit wash course: Use only special detergent designed of washing fruits.

#### Using the Tablet detergent


- ▶ If you wish to use tablet detergent such a : "2 in 1", "3 in 1", "4 in 1" etc...
- ▶ Press the "All in 1" button on the control panel.
- ▶ Before the start of the dishwashing program put Multi -detergent in the detergent dispenser.



# Detergent and Rinse-aid Dispenser

#### Water Softener


#### How to fill the rinse aid dispenser



- Rinse aid is needed to prevent spotting on dishes and glassware as well as improved drying performance.
- ▶When using "All in 1" 2 in 1, 3 in 1 tablet detergents, No rinse aid is needed.
- But you raise drying performance , you may pour rinse aid into the rinse aid dispenser.

#### How to adjust the dosage of rinse aid

- 1. Open the dishwasher door.
- 2. Remove the dispenser lid by pushing the cover.
- 3. Set the dosage level.
- 4. Close the dispenser lid.
- ▶ Turn the dosage adjuster at higher figure if spots appear on dry glassware.
- The dosage adjuster is pre-set to "6"-in the factory.
- It can be adjusted from 1 to 6.
- This dispenses approximately 3~5 ml of rinse aid per program.




#### ▶ Please take it in turns

- 1. Turn anti-clockwise to remove cap
- 2. Fill the salt in the salt container. Use a kind of funnel for easy and clean filling.

Filling with Special Salt for the Water Softener

- 3. After filling, wipe off any spilled salt to seal the cap properly.
- 4. Screw the cap tightly to prevent the suds penetration that may cause the water softing troubles.
- Fill with special salt
- Prior to using the dishwasher for the first time;
- Prior to using the dishwasher for the first time, After fill with special salt, pour the water in the salt container. (You initially pour the water only one time.)
- When the SALT indicator backlight on the control panel is illuminated
- Fill the container with special salt though the funnel:
   The capacity of the container is approx. 1kg
   depending on the grain size. Do not overfill the salt container with special salt.
- ► Example adding special salt





#### Water Softener

#### Filling with Special Salt for the Water Softener

- ▶ Use only special salt for dishwashers, Never fill the salt container with any another type or dishwasher detergent, this would irreparably damage the water softener.
- ▶ If you are not going to wash your dishes immediately, you should run the Quick program. This will wash away salt water that has run out of the container and any grains of salt that have been spilt.
- ▶ Depending on the size of the salt grains, it can take several hours for the salt to dissolve in the water and the special salt indicator backlight to extinguish.

#### Adjusting the Water Softening System

▶ Adjust the water softener accordinfg to the table below for the water hardness level for your area.

The water softener has 6 settings, (See the table)

- 1) The water softener is pre-set to "3" in the factory.
- 2) Water hardness is measured in equivalent scales, German degrees(°dH), French degrees(°TH) and mmol/l(International unit for the hardness of water)

## PART I

#### **Technical Aspects**

- ▶ Part II refers to the technical aspects of the Dishwasher and should be thoroughly read.
  - Technical repair work and service installation should be performed by a qualified service personnel. However, basic understandings on the operation of the dishwasher will be useful.



#### Installation

▶ Place the dishwasher on a stable and flat surface ground. A fragile or tilted surface may cause it to fall, causing serious damage.









▶ Do not expose the unit to rain or moisture



 $\blacktriangleright$  To prevent fire or shock hazard, avoid water from penetrating into the control panel.



▶ Do not expose direct under sunligh



#### Adjusting Level

▶ Rotate the leveler to adjust height. If the ground surface is to tilt, please call for a qualified service personnel.




#### Power source

▶ This product is operated only on AC 230V 50Hz power source.

#### Connecting the Hose (Inlet hose, Drain hose)

- \*\* The appliance is to be connected to the water mains using new hose-sets and that old hose sets should not be reused





#### Installation

#### Connecting to the water supply

- The dishwasher can be connected to cold and hot water supplies up to max. 60°C.
- The dishwasher must not be connected to open hot water appliances or instantaneous water heater.

#### ▶ Permitted water pressure

Lowest permitted water pressure : 0.03MPa	Consult your plumber if the water pressure is less than 0.03MPa
Highest permitted water pressure : 0.8MPa	If the water pressure is greater than 0.8MPa, a pressure reduction valve must be used(available from your dealer)

#### Connecting the inlet hose



The water inlet hose must not be kinked, crushed or entangled when it is being connected.

- Only tighten the nut hand tight.

Then do a visual check for a water leakage.

(Make sure that the tap is not driping)




#### Usual Care

#### **↑** CAUTION

Never use other chlorinated household detergents! Health hazard! Never use a steam cleaner to clean your dishwasher. The manufacturer is not liable for any consequential damage.

- ▶ Clean the cabinet with a soft cloth moistened with detergent solution and water.
- ▶ Do not use Benzine, Thinner or Insecticide and be careful not to scratch the surface of dishwasher.



#### Cleaning the Rotor

- ▶ The rotor should be cleaning regularly to avoid sticking of food leftovers in the rotor.
- ▶ Remove the rack.
- ▶ Pull the lower rotor firmly upwards to remove.
- ▶ Use a pointed object such as a toothpick to push food particles into the rotor.
- ► Rinse thoroughly under running water.
- ► Return the rotor and check that they rotate freely.








#### **Usual Care**

#### Cleaning the Filter

The filters must be regularly checked and cleaned. Dirty filters will degrade the washing result.

- 1. Open the door, Remove the rack.
- 2. The dishwasher filter system comprises a coarse filter(A), a micro-filter(B), a flat filter(C)



3. Turn the filter handle in an anti-clockwise direction and Remove the filter system inside of the dishwasher. Be careful not to drop the garbages into the dishwasher.



4. Remove the coarse filter from the flat filter. Remove the garbages by shaking coarse filter.



5. Remove the coarse particles. Clean all filters thoroughly under running water and clean both faces thoroughly.



7. Put the flat filter inside of the dishwasher.and lock by turning the filter handle clockwise to a stop. During this process ensure that the flat filter does not protrude above the base of the washing compartment.

⚠ Under no circumstances may the dishwasher be used without its filters.









#### No drain



- Check the route of the drain hose.
- Call for service

#### If the dishwashing result are not satisfactory

- ▶ The dishes are not clean.
- The wrong dishwashing program.
- The dishes were arranged is such a way that the dishwashing water did not reach all items.
- The racks must not be the overloaded.
- The filters in the base of washing compartment are dirty or incorrectly positioned.
- Too little or no detergent has been used.
- In the scale deposits on the dishes: The special salt dispenser is empty or the water softening system has been incorrectly set.
- The drain hose connection is not correct.
- The salt container cap is not properly closed.
- ▶ The dishes do not dry and are not shinning.
  - Rinse aid was not used.
- The rinse aid dispenser is empty.
- ▶ There are dried water drops on the glasses and dishes.
  - Increase rinse aid dosage
  - The detergent may be the cause. Contact the detergent manufacturer's customer advice center.






